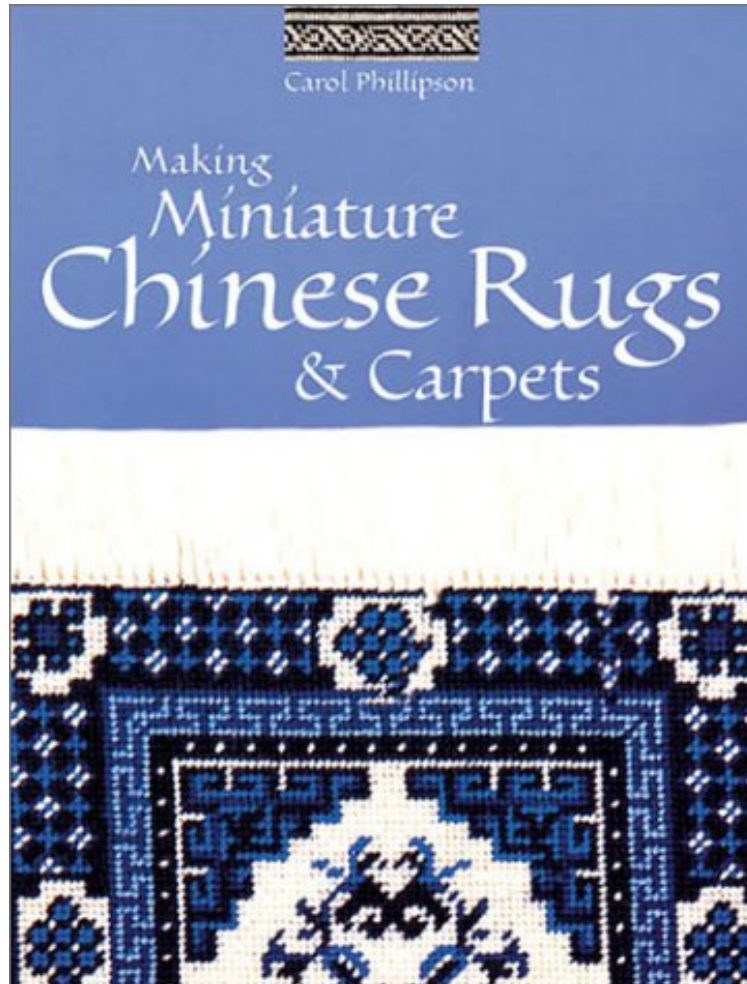

There is a good variety of designs and some interesting information about each. I have a few small criticisms: (1) the charts are color coded but there are no symbols in the charts to correspond to the colors, which makes it a challenge when there are closely similar colors. (2) Experienced miniaturists should note that all rugs are done on 22 count canvas and not a finer count which limits the amount of detail possible.4 of 4 people found the following review helpful.
