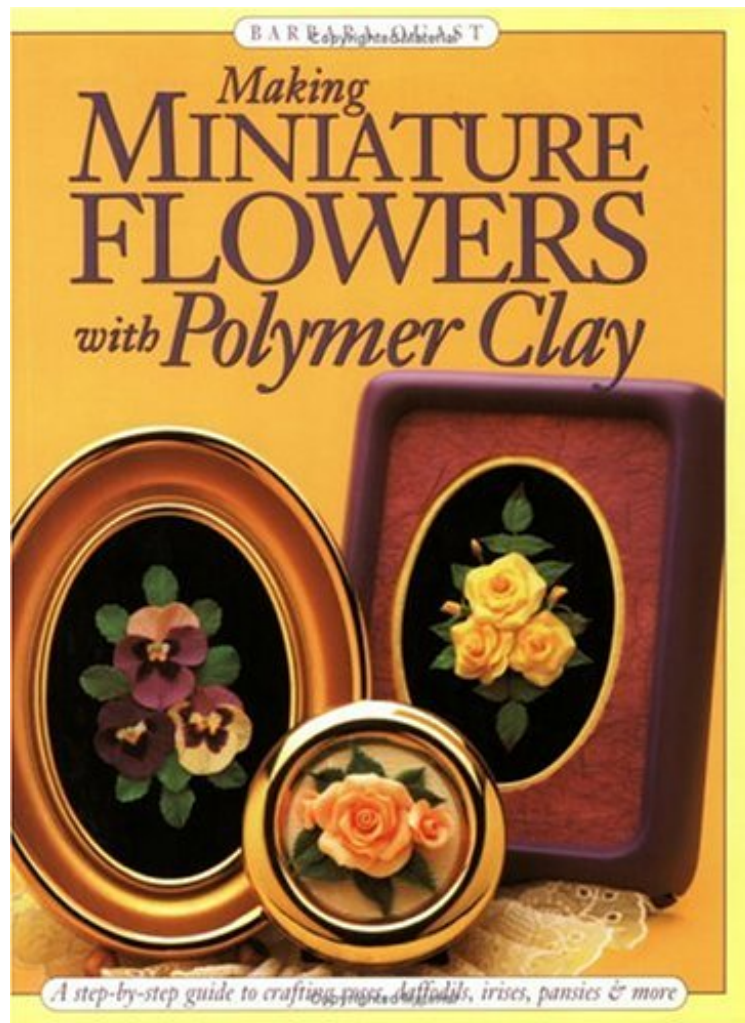

photos for each step leave a LOT to be desired!! They are so incredibly small that the hand holding the work in each photo is about the size of an 18" doll's! Since the clay flower parts are even smaller, I had to use a strong magnifying glass to see them! For example, the photo for the leaf for the rose, the leaf in the photo is about 1/4" big!! And we're supposed to use it as a construction example? Good golly!!
