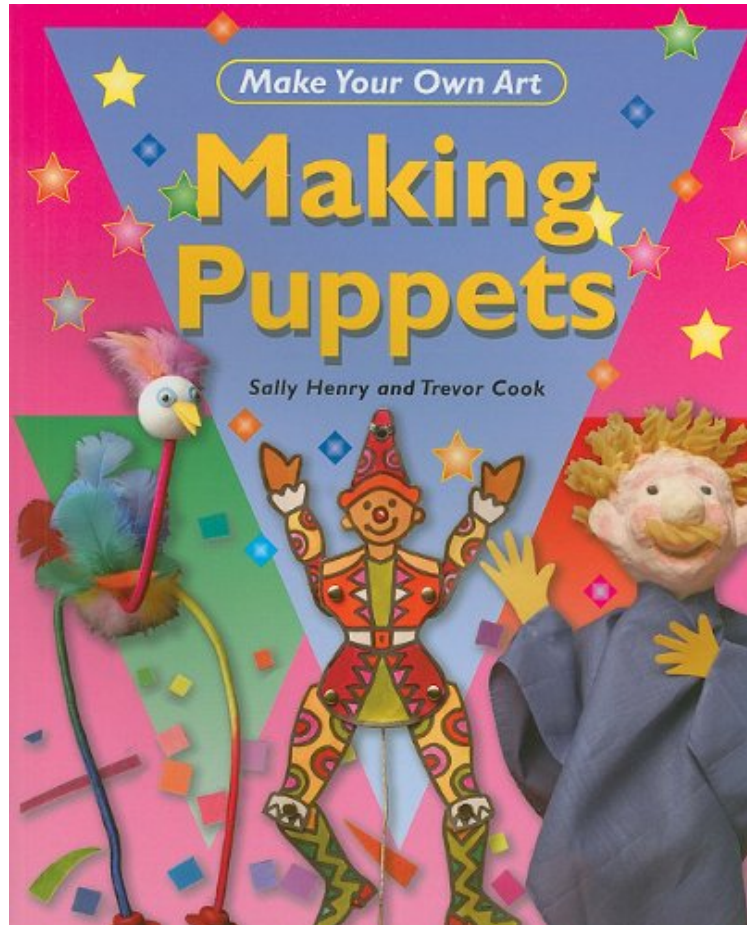

With easy-to-follow instructions, fun projects, and captivating photographs, this book will be a sure favorite for crafty kids and budding puppeteers.

From Booklist From Funny Birds to Jumping Jacks, this latest title in the Make Your Own Art series offers up puppet projects for a variety of abilities and ages. While it covers the well-known and beloved sock and finger puppets, it also presents some unusual options, like the Nutty Professor, a funny-looking guy with a face made out of dough and fusilli pasta hair. There are 11 sets of instructions in total, one of which includes directions for a shoe-box puppet theater.

The four-page introduction helpfully points out good materials to use for puppet projects, but many young readers may skip this overview and go straight to the activities. The step-by-steps for each project are clear, colorful, numbered, and come with time estimations for both project completion and cleanup. Not only is this a fun resource for crafty kids, but its also useful for librarians needing extra ideas for those ever-popular puppet programs and storytimes. A glossary and websites conclude.
