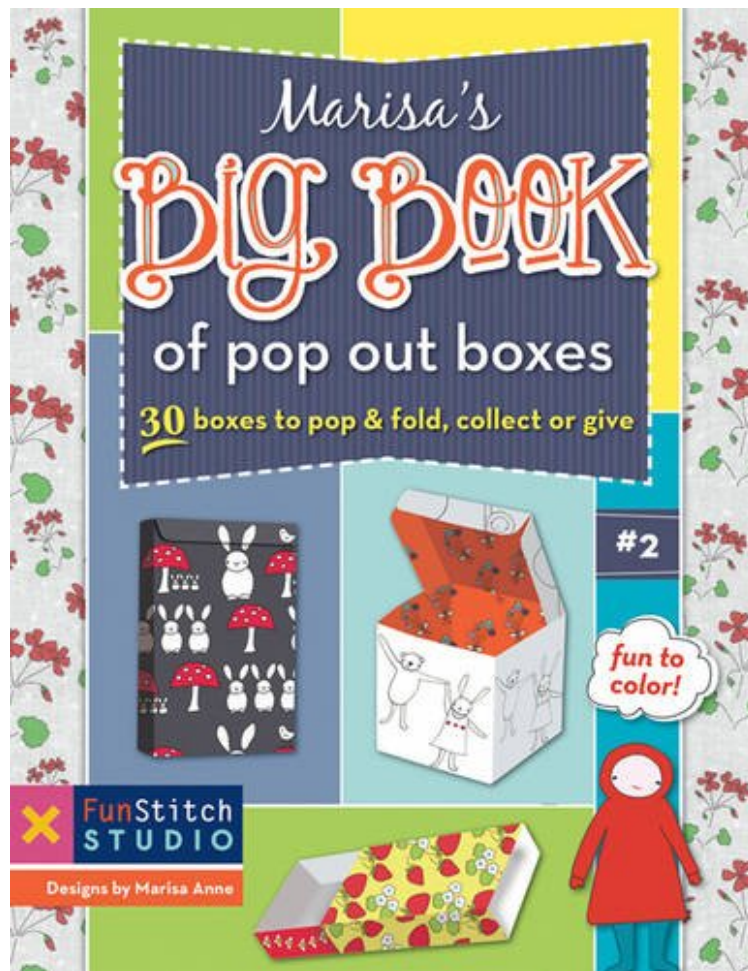

I can't speak highly enough about it! Each page had the most adorable patterns. She needed a little help with the assembly/folding part at first, but with a

little guidance she was able to do it on her own. Good project to teach spatial relationships - it was interesting for her to see how a flat piece could turn into a working box. They make great containers for little treasures, or can be used as gift boxes. Tip: We used a glue stick instead of tape to keep them together. The glue held the edges together just fine. If you use tape it will show and we felt it would detract from the finished product.
