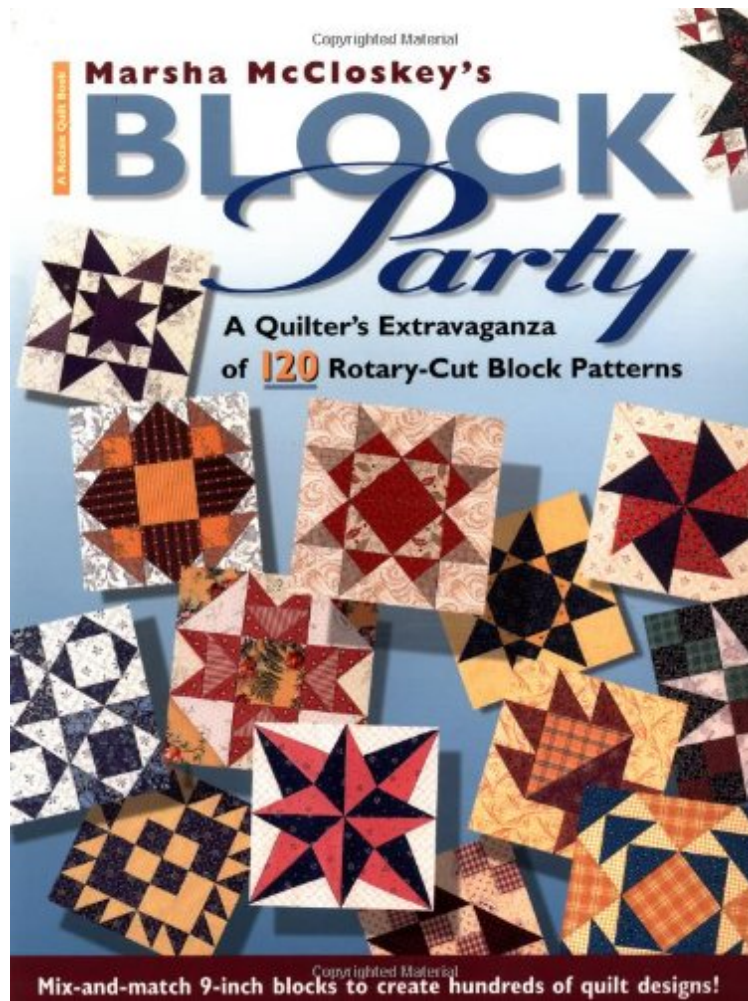

The book has so many ideas for making easy, basic quilts, and you can combine as few or as many different designs as you want because all of the finished blocks shown are the same size. I only have 3 quilting books and feel my library is complete with this one. The author breaks down the math for you, telling you how much fabric you need for each block, and contains a lined sketch that works very well when scanned onto your computer to use software such as Paint Shop Pro. I scanned each fabric piece, then added them to my computer's library, and was able to "paint" the fabric onto the sketch so I could see what each block would look like...BEFORE ever cutting anything. Has truly helped me decide on what colors go with what. This book is a must have and is well worth the \$\$!!!
