My first read through the instructions and my head was spinning, nothing made sense. I watched a few YouTube videos (links to the ones I found helpful below), and practiced making some swatches until I got the hang of it. After that, I went back to the book and suddenly the same write-ups made complete sense. It actually got easier for me when I started using the yarn included with the kit. It was much better quality than the yarn I bought to practice with.If you know how to crochet, I imagine this book is perfect. If you're totally new to it like me, just plan to spend time googling the terms and techniques, and watching videos. Here are a few that I used to understand the basic concepts (search for the video ID on YouTube)Getting started: aAxGTnVNJiEMaking a magic circle (starting each project): gEq48ABHRZoChanging color (also a great video of how to hold and work the project. Until I saw this I was working backward and inside out!): mB8eQ2e8580Closing up the project: SMkNQAZ5Si0Attaching limbs: 0qFxn6WMoKMIf you get into it like I did, you'll be needing more yarn and eyes. I found the authors Ravelry page where she lists the yarn used for the other characters. I made a chart which is attached here. The eyes can be purchased on : Sassy Bears 4.5mm Solid Black Safety Eyes for Bear, Doll, Puppet, Plush Animal and Craft - 10 PairsI'm just about finished my first character. He's not perfect, mistakes were made, lessons were learned. But it's been a lot of fun working on it and learning. I can't wait to tackle the rest of the characters.9 of 9 people found the following review helpful. Patterns for 12 Marvel Characters but kit contains supplies for making only 2 charactersBy iiiireaderI own a few of the Thunder Bay crochet character kits. This kit is similar in quality and I was able to purchase mine at a local big box store. It contains a small booklet

which contains instructions for 12 characters but be warned, the kit only contains enough materials to make 2 specifically, Captain America and Spider-man. Because of this, with prior kits and with this one as well, I substitute my own yarn and other materials so that I can keep the amigurumi consistent. I think that this kit and the patterns are good for intermediate and above. It would not be the first kit that I would give to a beginner to learn how to crochet. There are more advanced techniques used which, while there are good instructions, may be difficult for someone new to crochet to follow. If you are a beginner and want to work on these characters, it could be a fun challenge but I recommend having someone more experienced around to ask questions. This kit includes materials needed (except glue) to make Spider-Man and Captain America: yarns in royal blue, bright red, pale peach, white, denim blue and deep red; embroidery floss in black and white; white felt; a D (3.5mm) metal crochet hook; a yarn needle; a pair of safety eyes (Captain America has felt eyes in this kit so you only need one pair for Spider-man) and stuffing. While the author doesn't state which yarns she used, she does mention that she prefers acrylic for amigurumi (as do I) and that the patterns were designs for DK weight (size 3 light worsted). As I prefer to use a worsted weight in 4 for mine, my characters come out larger than the ones shown and generally take more yarn to finish. I like Vanna's Choice or Red Heart yarn for many of my characters as they have such a wide range of colors available. There are also fairly detailed instructions including many diagrams. The book includes instructions for 12 Marvel characters, including: Spider-man, Captain America, Hulk, Iron Man, Black Widow, Hawkeye, Thor, Ant-Man, Falcon, She-Hulk, Star-Lord, and Groot. I love that Star-Lord and Groot were included as my grandson really likes those characters from the movie. The hook is okay but I prefer to use my own for ergonomic reasons. The characters look to be fairly small - if you want to make them larger, use thicker yarn and larger hooks. The instructions should work well no matter the size. The tapestry needle is decent and works well for its purpose. I have purchased and crocheted other kits from this company (the Star Wars, Peanuts and Classic Disney) as well as one distributed by another company but which looks exactly like this brand with a slightly different box (Disney Winnie the Pooh). The instructions in the kits are all very similar as are the materials. If anything, I think that the photographs in this kit are an improvement and I was impressed with the older ones. On the whole, I really like the kit and the instructions and recommend it to an intermediate or above crocheter without hesitation.

The tiny eyes used for the figures are hard to use. I liked the figures that didn't require them like iron man. I did have one problem with the kit. the flesh colored yarn was way too small. It made Captain America's head not work for the pattern. I swapped out the kit yarn for other yarn I had and it worked much better. I have had to make multiple ones. Even my big kids like them.
