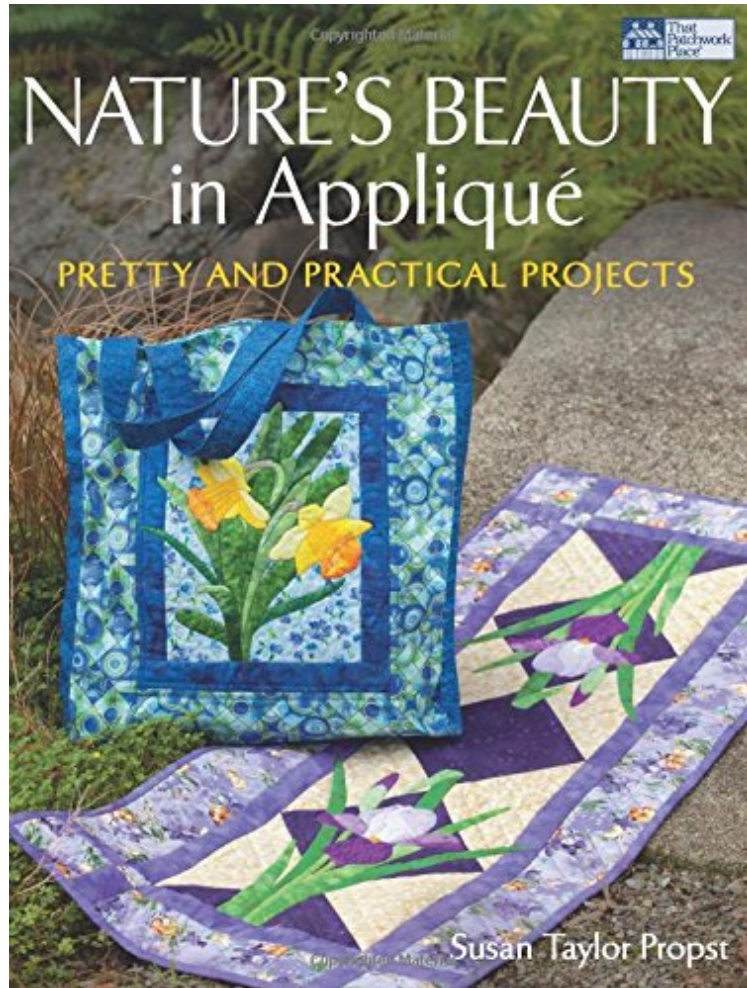

The projects range from small useful items to a layout diagram for the larger project. All nine quilt projects work equally well for both hand and/or fusible applique, and instructions are included for both methods. Full-size patterns are provided, as are creative ideas for using these patterns in your own quilt designs. The projects don't take a long time to complete, and they make wonderful gifts. Additionally, they can be simplified and made even more quickly when constructed from printed fabric without the applique.
