There are some really cute patterns in this book. All are fairly simple in design, but easy and quick to make. Using just pre cuts, you can turn out some simple and attractive simple quilts. The author does give some directions for changing the sizes for some of the patterns, as all the quilts made from one package of pre cuts are pretty small (crib or lap size mostly). The largest size she gives directions for expanding the patterns with additional package(s) of pre cuts are for twin bed size. I would

have liked to see directions for even larger quilts. However, if you do your own math, you can figure that out. Some of the patterns, however, would not be easy to resize due to their settings. 2 of 2 people found the following review helpful. I am thrilled to find a number of simpler designs which require less fabric, so I can use these designs to teach others to quilt. Also, I've experienced annoyance in the past with designs that although lovely, require the quilter to get a lot of extra yardage instead of just utilizing the pre-cuts. This book really is a bundle of fun, because you will actually find charming designs that only require a single pre-cut bundle. There are designs for jelly rolls, layer cakes and fat quarters. For small, simple designs, they are very charming! And will surely work up very fast, so they're appropriate for a last-minute baby shower gift, or just for the short-attention-span quilter (guilty). It would be a great addition to your library, even if you have heaps of quilting books. (I do.). I'm going to burn through my stash.
