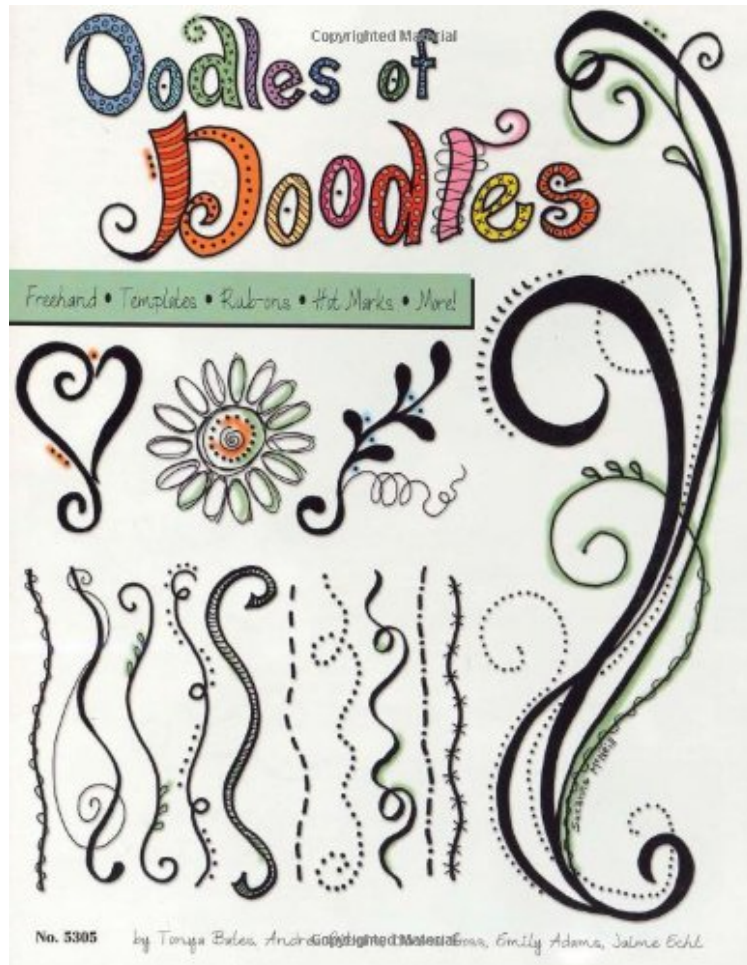

scrapbooking/doodling, you might enjoy this book. I was pretty disappointed because I've been doodling since I was a child, and most of these designs are similar to what I would create on my own. If you are looking for more intricate doodles, you won't find it in this book. There are few instructions, as most of the doodles are simple doodles you can look at and recreate. It's pretty common sense stuff. The book is rather thin (like most of Design Originals' books), so calling it "Oodles of Doodles" is a bit misleading. In all honesty, you are better off just googling "doodle ideas" or "scrapbook samples;" You will get more variety for no cost. What this book includes:-Written samples of about 20 pens-Tips for how to add doodles and lettering to scrapbook pages and cards-Tips for embellishing doodles (rhinestones whatnot)-Tips for what you can add to swirly lines-Several pages of doodle lettering-Zig zags and wavy lines-Doodle frames-A page of flower designs-A page of hearts and stars-A page of arrow designs-A small section on doodling with brads
