I have to say that both are excellent books. I cannot choose between the two, but this is more for toddlers than the other one. This one has brighter, more primary-like colors whereas the other one has more pastel colors, which is better for newborns and infants. There are 20 designs (21 if you separate the Pooh eating honey design) all of various sizes, and text too. The only thing I didn't like was the birth announcement text. I would have liked to have had a choice other than the alphabet in all lowercase, but I suppose it was more child-like that way. Still, I would have preferred a choice and the sampler text doesn't match the birth announcement text size either. The instructions are fairly clear, though some previous knowledge of cross-stitch is required (e.g., french knots, lazy daisy stitches, etc.).
