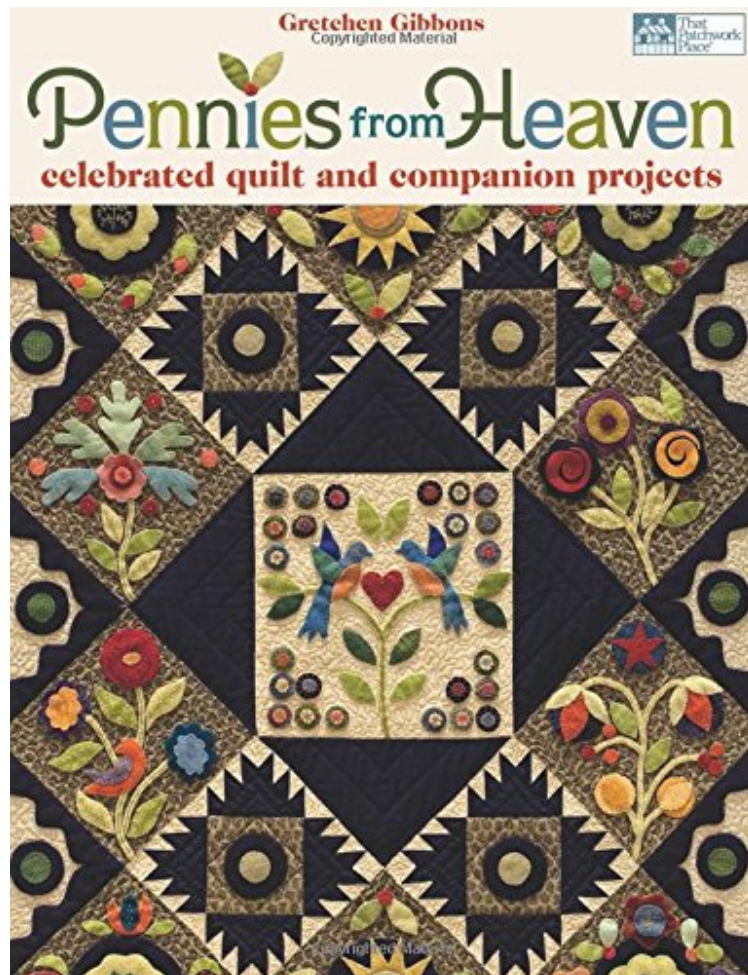

The finished size is 50 1/2" x 63 1/2". Also included are eight smaller projects using a block from the main quilt. These are nice if you want to try the technique out on a small scale first.
