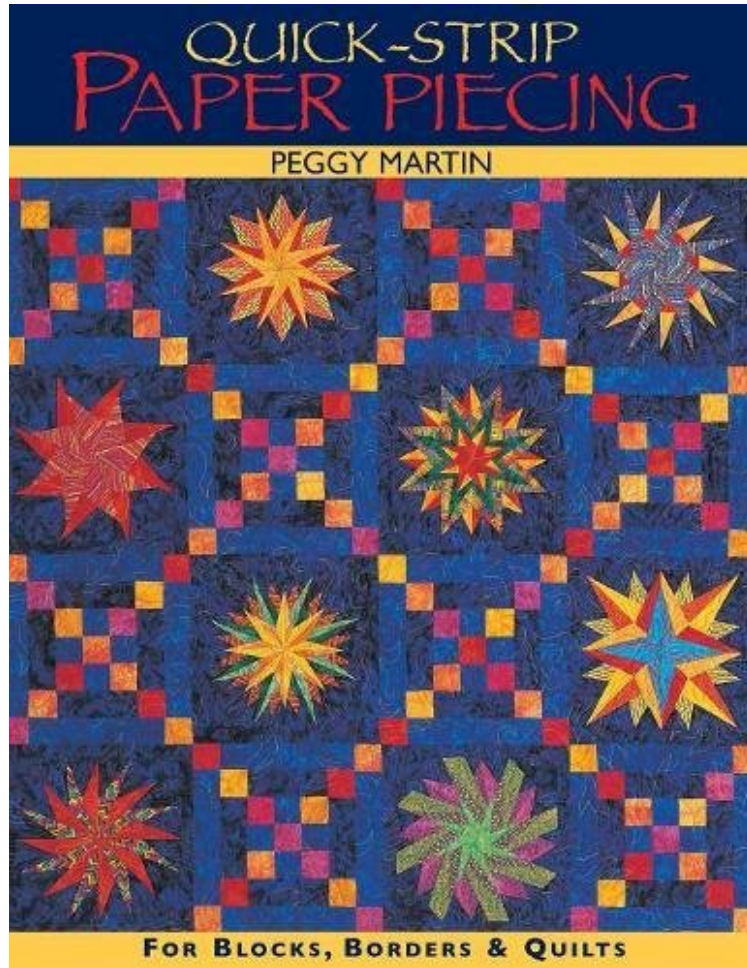

I put the blocks and flying geese together in my own design. The flying geese and small star look great on the boarder. I love this book! The star patterns are just beautiful! The instructions are easy to follow. I do NOT follow Peggy's unique/special instructions for paper piecing (sorry Peggy, I'm just old fashioned). I traced the pattern pieces and add 1/4" then cut them out and use these pieces as the pattern. I followed her instructions for the order in which to sew them together. This worked great. Every star turned out great. These were my very first quilts ever and I couldn't be happier. 14 of 14 people found the following review helpful. The value in it is in the stunning beauty of the finished product, but there are times during the construction of a paper-pieced project you can ask yourself, "What on EARTH was I THINKING?", and vow to never do it again. Martin takes the process and breaks it down into amazingly simple pieces (no pun intended) and gives you a QUICK way to do it. In addition, the patterns she has in this book are stunning. I haven't completed a block yet, but have done others using other more traditional methods, and I can tell this is a winner if you like the look of the types of projects requiring paper piecing as a reliable method of construction.
