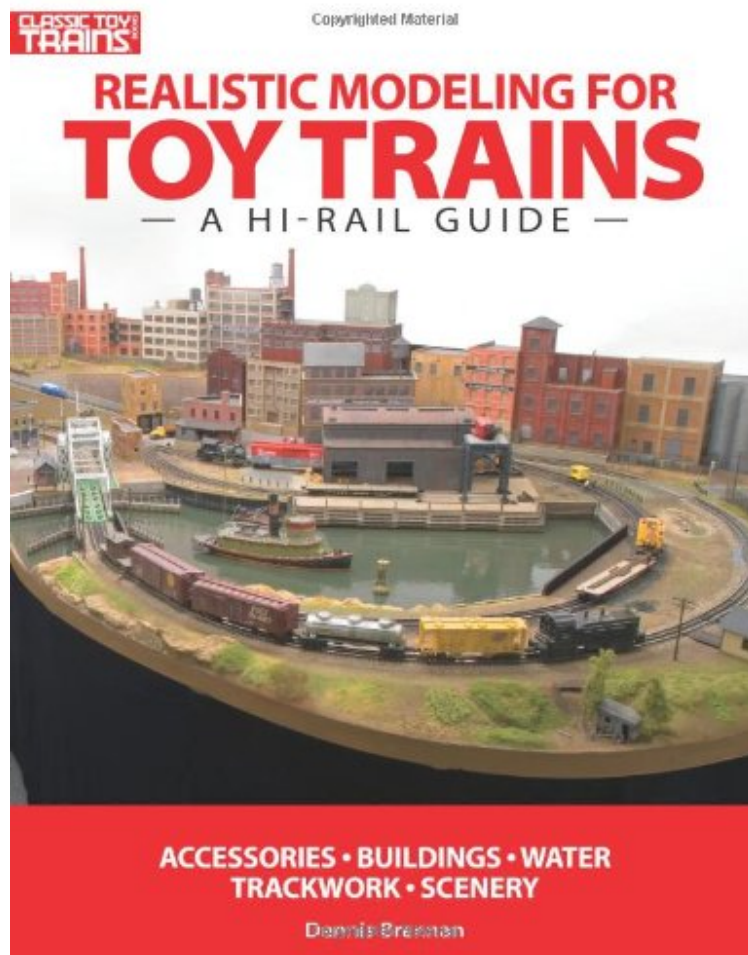

This book covers the building of this layout. You can use the ideas and techniques on your own layout, but you need to understand that. This book covers everything, but in a strange way IMO. all things are done to that one specific kit or part. Lots of referance to "the parts box" most of us do not have. I am just starting out, and do not have two girder bridges to cut and put together. So I say a good search of some forums or websites could have supplied this info. The pictures are good and there are some good ideas to be had.
